25-year-old male presents with multiple lacerations of left lower leg. The Patient was moving furniture at home when a metal shelf collapsed striking him on the leg. This occurred less than an hour prior to arrival, patient's immunization status in unknown. There is no significant past medical history. Patient has no other complaints.

- Exam BP 136/81, P 86, well-developed, well nourished in no acute distress
- Extremities: without edema AROM

- Skin: 2 cm and 4cm lacerations of left lower leg without obvious foreign body
- 4cm laceration thoroughly irrigated with saline. Area infiltrated with Lidocaine with Epinephrine. Subcutaneous tissues closed with two 4-0 vicryl sutures. Skin closed with twelve 4-0 running nylon. Td is updated.
- 2cm laceration prepped in the same manner and skin closed with seven 4-0 nylon.
- Patient is discharged home with follow-up instructions.
