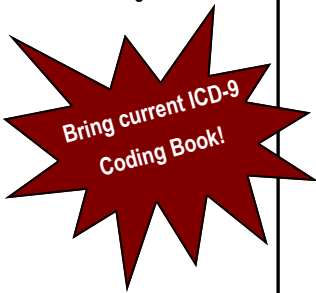

The registration fee for the exam is \$249 and recertification is \$129. The fee is set by BMSC and must be paid in advance and sent directly to BMSC. Candidates who complete the workshop and pass the exam will automatically earn the 10 CEUs necessary to renew their certification next year. Current HCS-D coders, who attend the workshop, will receive 10 CEUs towards their HCS-D certification maintenance.
